
October 1st 1958

Elvis bought his white "BMW 507" at a car dealership in Frankfurt am Main.


February 3rd 1959

Elvis visited the local lake "Gederner See". Photo, on the left, Mrs. Rosemarie Praß




August 18th 1959



farewell at the "Ray Barracks".




March 2nd 1960



The official opening of the "Elvis Presley Plaza" in Friedberg.


March 13th 1998
